## Exterior Condition

### **Front Cover**

The front cover retains strong color saturation and visible surface gloss, particularly in the central field. Minor bottom-edge abrasion affects approximately 6–12 mm intermittently, limited to surface thinning. The spine edge shows very light handling wear with no cracking, splitting, or paper loss. Corner rounding is present on all four corners, extending approximately 3–5 mm inward, without fiber separation. No creases, folds, or stains intrude into the artwork field.

## **Back Cover**

The back cover displays a yellow background with diffuse areas of darker age toning across the upper-left and mid-left portions, spanning approximately 30–60 mm. The toning lacks defined borders and does not exhibit tide lines or edge concentration. Light edge wear affects approximately 5–10 mm intermittently. Corners show rounding of approximately 3–5 mm. No paper loss, cockling, or distortion is observed.

## **Spine & Staples**

The spine remains straight, well aligned, and continuous, with no cracking, splitting, or material loss. Both staples are present and seated. The upper and lower staples exhibit light oxidation, with adjacent paper discoloration extending approximately 1–2 mm from the staple crowns. No tearing or slot enlargement beyond approximately 1 mm is visible.

## **Interior Pages**

**Page Color:** Tan to light tan

Interior pages are complete and securely attached. Uniform age-related toning is present, darker toward outer margins and lighter near gutters. Minor bottom-margin waviness affects approximately 10–20 mm on some pages. Small lower-corner bends extend approximately 4–6 mm inward. No tears, writing, staining, ink transfer, or moisture distortion is visible. Artwork remains clear and legible with strong color retention.

## **Moisture / Warpage**

No moisture staining, tide lines, cockling, or paper distortion observed.

## Grade-Impacting Defects

- Light, bounded edge abrasion
  - Moderate corner rounding
  - Uniform age-related paper toning
  - Light staple oxidation
